The pre-bid report is a compilation of information starting from the conception phase of the active bid phase. It informs stakeholders of future construction procurement opportunities and includes information such as project name, details, estimated budget, as well as information on the viability of projects and design updates throughout the pre-bid phases.

- **planroom**

The exclusive online planroom is a province-wide collaboration hosting 1000 plus construction bid opportunities per year via a secure web application under the buildsask umbrella of services.

- **restricted access planroom**

Provides identical project information as the planroom, but allows those posting projects to restrict access to select bid opportunities.

- **lows and awards report**

This report provides post-bid results on the final phase of the bidding process, listing the low bids and award results.

- **link2build**

Link2build is the gateway to a rich database of national construction bid opportunities that are aggregated from Canada's local construction associations. The project information listed on the Link2Build web site provides FREE access to over 20,000 basic project details annually along with access to over 12,000 local, provincial and national contractors, manufacturers and suppliers.
