The online Plan room, BuildWorks is a partnership between local construction associations across the three prairie provinces providing construction opportunities. BuildWorks delivers unparalleled exposure for private and public owners of construction to post bidding opportunities for contractors.

The shared public directory is the largest and most comprehensive database of contractors offering advertising at several levels for subscribers. All subscribers receive a free basic listing in the directory.

This platform delivers valuable construction information over and above the projects listed. It is the consummate hub to promote your company and source construction information.

Networking is the connection with members and stakeholders. The RCA offers several networking events per year, a chance to meet and mingle casually. Often there is a guest speaker, a member or a government representative. The President's Event is the highlight, two golf tournaments run a close second and the curling was new this year – a resounding success. There are many more throughout the year.

The Future Construction Leaders is a group of younger members (forty and under) who meet socially to learn about the industry through education presentations, site tours, etc., which helps build confidence in advancing their careers, experience mentoring, learn more about the Association and perhaps explore what it takes to become a Board member.

Education continually evolves dependent upon member demand and what is new in the industry. Classes range from a half day to three full days, instructors are carefully vetted, class evaluations are posted on the RCA web site as is the class schedule. There is full line up of online classes as well. All classes count toward Gold Seal points.

Breakfast Cafes and Power Lunches offer an informal format with both social and educational aspects. Often members present, as does the government.

Member Promotion

The RCA is proud of our members and makes every effort to promote member companies to each other and the community through our Broadcasts, digital signage, social media, website and Sponsorship.

Broadcasts are electronically distributed, the weekly Wednesday Broadcast reports the pre-bid, active projects, and the post-bid Lowes and Awards results. The other Broadcast is published every second Friday highlighting upcoming events, industry news, promotes sponsors, new members and member profiles.

Advocacy

City of Regina

The RCA has enjoyed particular success this year on behalf of members with the City of Regina. Permit times with the City has been an on-going issue. Kevin Dureau, our Executive Director, at the City's request, was asked to sit on a Permit Review Committee. Kevin invited several members to participate. This Committee met every two weeks for three months to collaborate with industry partners to design and deliver recommendations on improving the processing time for permit approval. The recommendations were sent to City Council for approval in January 2020. The permit times went from months to days for approval – commercial twenty days, resubmissions five.

This advocacy has enhanced the relationship with the City. The RCA has had opportunities to present member issues to the City with positive outcomes for both members and the City.

Saskatchewan Construction Association

The RCA supports the advocacy work done by the provincial body with the province. The Director attends SCA political and social events to further promote member interests.

Canadian Construction Association

The CCA represents the membership federally and develops the CCDC and CCA contracts used throughout the industry.
